



Mosaics for Beginners +

Monday 14th January – 18th March 2019

Description

Have fun creating colourful handmade mosaics. Whilst all abilities are welcome, this course is ideally suited to those with basic or no previous mosaicking experience. You will learn and try out simple tiling techniques, using different types of tiles (such as glass and resin) on various media (including glass and ceramic). You will learn how to mix and apply grout to your creations for that finished look. Some weeks will be tiling, others will be grouting. We will also consider how colours and shapes work together, plus other aspects of mosaic design.

By the end of the course, you will have created a selection of mosaic homewares including a coaster, a tea light holder and a flower pot. These items will be both decorative and functional, and will also make beautiful gifts.

All work will be carried out in class, with guidance and supervision.

All materials and equipment are provided.

What to bring: A container in which to carry items home and back between classes. For first week, this will be a box around 12 x 12cm (e.g. a Tupperware or margarine tub). Wear old clothes that you don't mind getting dirty, particularly for the grouting sessions.

Extra costs: £5 per person for materials
